Intergenerational Partnership

Carmen House Residential Home on Carmen Lane (opposite Hillmount) have been in touch to invite a small group of the children to go and sing some Christmas songs with their residents. The home is a small setting for 15 older people, many of whom don't have family they see often.

Miss Algie has agreed that a small group of children, across all three classes, will be able to go and sing with the residents. If you and your child would like to come along to this please speak to Miss Algie, we have space for around 15 children to go with Parents. We will meet at Carmen House on Thurs 14th at 10am and stay for around 45 minutes. This is a new partnership for the school and hopefully will be one that will bring a little Christmas Joy to everyone!

Cold and Flu Season

If your child is unwell and needs to have Calpol or other similar medicine before coming to school, please let them stay at home. Children who are unwell are much better off at home where they can rest and recuperate instead of sitting in a busy classroom when they feel unwell. We ask that any unwell children stay at home until they are better and are fully able to participate in all the areas of Nursery School again.

Some children may have seasonal asthma - if your child has an inhaler please complete the medical form so we can give this in school if needed.

Getting Ready to Learn

We hope your child is enjoying their Book Bag each Tuesday! We have a selection of these bags and they rotate between all three classes. - so you should get 9 different book bags through the project.

After Christmas we will be sending home bags that are not just Book Bags. There are a variety of bags - book bags with three different types of book to read and explore with your child, activity bags that might help develop maths skills or thinking skills in a fun and playful way, Fine motor skill bags to help your child's muscles in their fingers and hands develop (important for life but also for learning to write) Rhyme bags to help develop a sense of steady beat and rhyme (important pre-reading skills).

Please note that the value of each bag is around £30. Please take care of the book bag and its contents, we know that accidents happen from time to time but encourage your child to take care of the resources they are being lent and do not allow them to use them unsupervised. In the rare event of any deliberate destruction a replacement fee will be charged.

Tips for using the Book/Activity bags

- Open them at home in a tidy area (many bags contain lots of bits, this means they won't get lost!)
- Talk about the contents of the bag with your child
- Set some quiet, uninterrupted time aside to play/read/ sing/complete the activities with your child. It doesn't have to be long but it should be quality time set aside to invest in their learning.
- Don't ask lots of fact based questions its not a test for your child but should be an enjoyable experience.
- Check the bag's contents before you return it to school.
 Each bag will have a list of contents. If you loose anything please inform the class teacher.

CHRISTMAS CARDS

Sometimes children want to send cards to their friends. The easiest way to do this is for them to leave the 'To" part blank and bring in a set of 25 cards signed with their name (or their own version of their name!).

All envelopes can be blank so the children can "post" them into their friends boxes independently.

SONGS

We are practising our special Christmas songs in school. These will be recorded and sent home on Seesaw. We don't want to spoil the children's performance but these are some of the trickier Christmas songs you could practice at home

Thank you to Parents

As a small standalone school we would not be able to function as well without the support of the parents. Thank you for keeping up to date with your contributions to snack/enrichment fund that allow us to provide extra things for the children that would not be possible within the school budget alone. As a few examples visits from the Ark Open Farm cost us around £660 every year and visits from the theatre/drama groups range from £250 to £500. These things are wonderful enrichment opportunities for the children. The costs are subsidised by the school so in an average month the value of trips/visitors/ activities alongside the cost for the healthy snack exceeds the £20 per month donation that we ask for from parents.

We are unable to pay for these visitors and enrichment activities without the support of parents but we hope that you agree the children benefit so much from having different people in to school!

If at any time your financial circumstances change and the Snack/Enrichment Activity fund causes extra pressure please speak to Miss Algie
